What to Expect from your Online Dog Training Experience with Tails-U-Win!

Welcome to our online dog training classes! There are a few things you need to know.

Our online classes do require a camera. You can use a PC laptop, a camera on your phone in most modern smartphones, a Macbook, a Tablet or iPad device.

We will be using Zoom Video Conferencing for our weekly live group class where you will receive instruction and feedback from your instructor, as well as be able to see your classmates and hear their feedback and instruction. You will be training during the live group class.

When you register for an online class, you will

receive information regarding homework, instructor expectations, instructions on how to access your Facebook support group, and more!

Each week after your live group class, you will receive your additional homework for the following week so that you can practice and practice some more. We recommend that practice training last approximately 5-10 minutes and can be done multiple times throughout the day.

You should not have to download anything on your phone or device that you are using.

We do recommend testing your camera prior to class and getting set up so that you know when you

and your dog are in-frame. This includes setting up cones or similar objects so that you know where you can stand with your dog.

Anyone else involved in the training should be in the same room, using the same device. It can get complicated if everyone joins on different devices.

Most classes will be part lecture, part demonstration and will include ample time for you to get feedback from your instructor to continue making progress with the exercises you have been given.

instructor if you do not have a Facebook account. You can also upload videos to Youtube with privacy settings Unlisted and send to your instructor for analysis and feedback.
